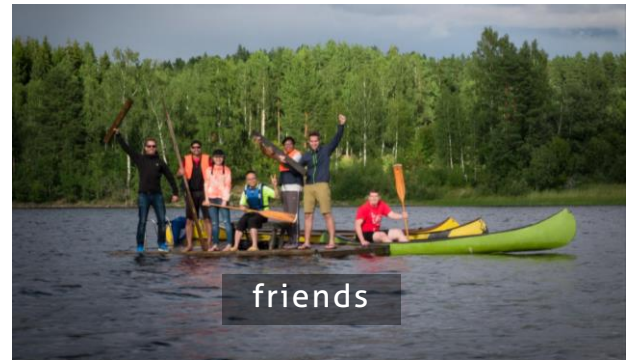


Invitation and Call for Applications

Registration fee

Application

Applicants are required to fill in the application form on the NSCAS website www.nscas.se and submit an abstract describing your current research before April 24. Invited participants should then fill in the final application form and pay the registration fee no later than May 22. Invitations are limited to a maximum of 15 participants. The applications indicating the highest quality and relevance are to be invited.

Poster Sessions

Each participant is expected to bring a poster in an A1 format. The posters will be used in different sessions, expositions and conferences.
